

Summary

What a joy it was to be with you all last week! Francis and Sally Prittie led a meeting in their house last night called 'Everybody has a story to tell' (based on the talk I never gave on the first morning of the conference!) We enjoyed deep and precious worship together, in which the Lord encouraged us to press into His presence and to move out into the initiatives He is leading us into. Everybody had precious stories to share about how the Lord had met with them during the week.

During the conference week, the Lord warned us that His judgements are over our nations now, and that there is much that we can no longer avert ~ but that if we will allow His scalpel to work deeply in the heart of His Church, then this judgement can still be used redemptively rather than destructively. This is vital for the future of Europe.

As we began to intercede for our continent, the Lord said: **Come and ask me for Your people, come and ask Me for your nations, the sceptre is extended out to you**".

It was so important to press into the throne room of God in prayer. We were privileged to experience, at least in part, a sense of what people prophesied: that Hjaltland (Shetland) – is 'the hilt of the sword' – we were certainly privileged to wield the sword on behalf of the nation. We prayed for the following on Saturday morning



We had a sense that the eagle (the prophetic move of God) will rise up again in Germany, where the prayer movement is strong and well developed across 400 cities, despite the many difficulties and disappointments the nations is currently experiencing. We felt particularly to pray for the power of God to move in Stuttgart.



The word was given: the spiritual icecap in Iceland will melt like a volcano under a glacier.



As we prayed for the power of the Holy Spirit to infill and empower the church in Faroe, we were given words, 'the water is coming, flowing over the hard places.'



Intercessors for Orkney were told that the white winged bird can arise again. Build again a community with the body of believers – the community of God. "You, O Shetland are a land of quiet meditation, Holiness is whispered in your bones, and holiness will once more







revive the dead bones in My bride. I will use you to impart life, but first let me breathe on you and bring you refreshing. Let me quicken you to the cross and to trust me once more. Let me break the isolation on your back."

Three of the themes I outlined on the final morning:

- i) **Get people quickly to the point of prayer**: Have the courage to say 'let's pray together!' As we move from information to prayer we are making frameworks that the devil hates and that God uses mightily!
- ii) **Get real people doing real things.** The day of spectator Christianity is over. God wants to develop frameworks where every person has the chance to contribute effectively. (James Rutz has written a challenging new book on this theme called 'Megashift' Empowerment {Press, Colorada Springs).
- iii) Be prepared to go the extra mile. Remember, the evening the Lord touched the Shetland musicians? It all happened because Lindsey Cummings, when she realised that Francis had left his violin back at our house, went all the way home to fetch it. As she drove along, she said to the Lord, 'Every session has been so amazing, Lord is there really anything new left that You can do?' The Lord replied very clearly, 'My treasure chest is never empty!' And didn't the Lord prove the truth of this during the week! The Lord had promised that He would knit together the contributions of the nations into something very precious to Himself. It was so powerful to interweave music and intercession, and to invite people to participate wherever possible. I am only sorry we could not have devoted still more time to pray!

Well done the twenty year olds for leading the time of prayer for Faroes – it was awesome! When you met together and cooked a meal together at the hotels, and invited others along too, you were demonstrating that church works well as a verb as well as a noun!

Please remember to pray for **Bjorn Olav Hansen** and his family. He had to return early to speak at another conference, but he has been forced to leave his post as pastor of Lillehammer Baptist Church in Norway, because of his stand against the ordaining of homosexual pastors.

May the Lord keep our hearts free from the 'Janteloven' stronghold, as it tries to limit our freedom, demean our integrity and keep us in rigid straightjackets and boxes. May we recognise that we, as nations, are under God's judgement, but cultivate the minutes and cry out in repentance, thus using even the judgement of God redemptively.

May Shetland become more and more a spiritual gateway and a place where people come to experience the Lord's healing presence!
